
WMO Aeronautical Meteorology Scientific Conference 2017

- Three sessions:
 - Science underpinning meteorological observations, forecasts, advisories and warnings
 - 2) Integration, use cases, fitness for purpose and service delivery
 - Impacts of climate change and variability on aviation operations and associated science requirements
- Outcomes serving to inform WMO Members, constituent bodies and others of the strategic direction for scientific research in support of aviation over the coming 10-15 years or more





8th International Workshop on Volcanic Ash (IWVA/8)



- Convened by WMO in collaboration with:
 - ICAO
 - Host country and other sponsors (if any)
- IWVA are self-funded by the participants
 - i.e. no WMO financial support is available
- Local arrangements are provided by the host country
- 3-year cycle on average
 - But was linked with every other meeting of the (now defunct) IAVWOPSG





8th International Workshop on Volcanic Ash (IWVA/8)



- Most recent:
 - IWVA/5, 2010 (Santiago), ~40 participants, 5 days
 - IWVA/6, 2013 (Chiteko), ~65 participants, 5 days
 - IWVA/7, 2015 (Anchorage), ~95 participants, 3.5 days followed by 1.5 days VASAG/6
- IWVA/8 timing considerations
 - 2017 too late
 - Other major events incl. WMO AeroMetSci (Nov), ICAO GANIS/2 and SANIS/1 (Dec)
 - 2018 problematic?
 - Other major events incl. WMO CAeM-16/TECO (July), ICAO METP/3 (Sept) and AN-Conf/13 (Oct)
 - 2019 possible?
 - Other major events incl. ICAO A40 (Sept/Oct)
