Progress with the 'Transition Plan'

Discussed:

- Introductory presentations on the transition plan
- Proposals and state of progress
- Main outcome(s)
 - PTC/PRA meeting to be used as a 'sounding board' to inform 'decisions' at the TT-CBR meeting on the Friday... PTCs not invited to attend
 - LOTS of work still needing to be done before April 2020, next major milestones being SOP in April and Cg-18 in June 2019
 - CCl requested 2022 final implementation date...
 option not on table at this time



Structures of (new) TCs and Research Board

Discussed:

- Transition of existing TC functions to new TC and RB structure
- Showcases of how key commitments are transferred to new structures consistently with OP

- New roles being defined for RAs, 2 TCs, Research Board, Technical Coordination Committee (TCC) and various Panels that may or may not be established
- P/CAeM sought clarification from SG regarding future structures of 32 WMO Programmes... decisions post-Cg18
- (1) Infrastructure (COIIS) and (2) Services (CSA) joint TC IG meeting 20-24 April 2020.



Processes, procedures and guidance

Discussed:

- Definitions (regulations) and modalities of TC subsidiary bodies
- Inclusiveness regional, gender, etc.
- Format of joint TCs and RB
- Procedural Handbook and amendment to Gen. Regs.

- TT-CBR looking after Handbook and Gen. Regs
- Congress likely to sit every 2-years
- Bigger role and budget for RAs in defining TC priorities, membership, oversight and regional implementation



Cross-cutting and multi-stakeholder areas

Discussed:

- Ensuring continuum in the 'value chain' (S2S, R2O)
- Role of EC TCC Technical Coordination Committee
- Centralized approach for key function capacity development
- Oceans and IOC consultation process
- Polar and high mountain activities (EC-PHORS)
- Hydrological community consultation process

- TCC will bring RAs and TCs together to review priorities and provide additional oversight of implementation
- Research Board & supporting Science Advisory Panel (SAP) thinking well advanced (current P/CAS led)
- Greater outreach & engagement with other UN bodies, academia and private sector
- CHy-Ext in Feb 2019 to recommend some form of IG meeting option for Hy
- WMO-IOC Board currently defining what fits where in new structures



Communication

- Discussed:
 - Status of a Communications Strategy
 - Role of PRA and PTC as advocates of WMO Reform
- Main outcome(s):
 - No time to discuss but all PTCs encouraged during week to provide 'talking head' to camera highlighting benefits of reform!



Regional perspectives

Discussed:

 WMO Reform perspectives of the presidents of regional associations

- Proposal for establishment of new EC Panel of Experts on Capacity Development (would absorb EC-ETR) supported by development of CD plan
- IG RAs continuing every 4-years, PTCs to attend
- Country Profile Data Base (CPDB) an increasingly important tool



Public-Private Engagement (PPE)

Discussed:

 Draft Policy Act on PPE (as developed by PPE Task Force chaired by Michael Staudinger)

- Redrafted 'Geneva Declaration' stronger with respect to roles/responsibilities of WMO. To go to Cg-18
- WMO Global Data Conference to be convened in late-2019
- Global Basic Observations Network Standards to go to Cg-18
- All above likely in some shape or form to open up review of Res 25, 40 (incl. aviation data note in Annex IV, <u>AeM</u> <u>LTP consideration?</u>) and 60 data policies.



Global Framework for Climate Services

Discussed:

- GFCS mechanism in the proposed WMO structure
- GFCS governance
 - Recommendations from GFCS Management Committee
- WMO contribution to GFCS
 - Regional action plan roll-out, operationalization of climate services, climate services training inventory, etc.
- Main outcome(s):
 - Proposal to go to Cg-18 to replace IG IBCS with non-IG ExCOM body
 - Supporting Climate Coordination Panel (CCP) reporting to TCC to define priorities & provide oversight
 - COIIS and CSA respective responsibilities to be determined



Country support initiative

- Discussed:
 - Presentation by President of RA VI
- Main outcome(s):
 - Opportunity to improve WMO coordination of GCF, WB, PPE etc. funding opportunities
 - WMO to define capability gaps and priorities
 - New 'WMO Director of Development Partners' leading.
