#### Summary and purpose of document

This document contains the statements of account concerning the ASAP Trust Fund for the period 2004 to 2006.

#### **ACTION PROPOSED**

The ASAP Panel is invited to:

- (a) Review and approve the statements of account, as appropriate;
- (b) Adopt a budget for 2007;
- (c) Consider whether any new contribution(s) may be required.

#### DISCUSSION

- 1. As agreed at the seventh Session of the ASAP Coordination Committee (ACC-VII, June 1995) and at the request of the Chairperson of the ACC, the WMO Secretariat is maintaining a Trust Fund on behalf of the ACC, and its successor the Automated Ship Aerological Programme Panel (ASAPP). As agreed at Fourteenth Session of the ASAP Panel (ASAPP-XIV, SOT-II, London, United Kingdom, 2003), this Trust Fund was used to support the WRAP Project, including the contract for project leader.
- 2. The statement of account for this Trust Fund from the period 1 January 2004 to 31 December 2005 is provided in Appendix A to this document. The following points should be noted:
  - (a) Invoiced contributions for 2004 and 2005 have been received (as shown);
  - (b) The WRAP contribution (from Australia) for 2005 has been received (as shown);
  - (c) The contract for the project leader, as agreed at ASAPP-XIV (SOT-II) and reported at SOT-III, is indicated in the appropriate line (consultancy);
  - (d) The expenditures for equipment that were spent in 2004 and reported at SOT-III.
- 3. The statement of account for this Trust Fund for the period 1 January 2006 to 31 December 2006 is provided in Appendix B. The following points should be noted:
  - (e) WRAP Consumables were paid to the United Kingdom Met Office in 2006;
  - (f) WMO support cost of 7% was charged to the Trust Fund.
- 4. The Panel is invited to review, provided comment(s) and/or suggestions regarding the statement and, if satisfied, approve said statement accordingly.
- 5. The ASAP Panel is invited to consider how the remaining fund should be used, and whether any additional contribution may be needed. For example, past expenditures included: the contract of the WRAP Project Manager, WRAP (consumables, installation and management, payment to observers, travel for both the project leader and Australian manager), to balance the specific contribution; publications; and some travel. If required, invoices for 2007 contributions will be issued after this session discusses the future of the ASAP Trust Fund.
- 6. The Panel is invited to prepare its budget for the remainder of 2007 and eventually adopt it.
