2012 Final Accounts

- DBCP Trust Fund is still in good health but changes:
- •2012 contributions US\$ 72.7 (2011: US\$ 410.6)
 - Australia, Germany, India, New Zealand, South Africa, CLS
 - •Lower than budgeted for (US\$ 289.5, Can, MF in 2011)
- •2012 expenditure US\$ 381.3 (2011: US\$ 227.3)
 - Technical Coordinator (Salary and Relocation Cost)
 - •WMO/IOC Support Cost
 - DBCP Representation
 - Capacity Building
 - •Iridium, Technical Development, SLP Pilot
- •2012 Cash Balance WMO+IOC US\$ 391.7 (2011: US\$ 690.4)

2013 INTERIM STATEMENT

- •BALANCE (31 July 2013): US\$ 421.2 (WMO+IOC) (31 July 2012 : US\$ 583.9)
- •Interim Budget 1 Jan. 2013 US\$ 505.8
- •Carry over from 2012: US\$ 391.7
- •Contributions received: US\$ 108 (Aus, SA, MF, CLS) (Budgeted for 2013: US\$ 379.5)
- •Total Expenditure/Obligations so far: US\$ 84.6 (31 July 2012: US\$ 147.2)
 - •TC Transition, Travel, Support Cost, JCOMMOPS

2012 & 2013 FINANCIAL STATEMENT JCOMM Trust Fund

- DBCP EB had recommended to include the Statement of Accounts of JCOMM TF into the DBCP Statement of Accounts;
- •Joint Presentation, JCOMM TF not impacting the DBCP TF;
- Necessary clarification on details of contribution/expenditure not yet available however;
- •WMO 2012 Final Statement and WMO 2013 Interim Statement on JCOMM TF for information only (App. D&F).





BUDGET 2014 and 2015

Based on:

- •Carry Over, Income (e.g. Contributions) and Expenditure (Balance 2014: US\$ 307.2K; 2015 US\$ 193.1K based on <u>actual</u> estimations and plans)
- Must be reviewed and updated by Executive Board after Panel Discussion
 - Constant/Increase level of Income
 - Employment Technical Coordinator
 - Travel
 - Capacity Building/(Additional) Workshops
 - Technical Development (incl. PPs)
 - SOT activities
 - IOC position (income/expenditure)
 - Other

RECOMMENDATIONS to the DBCP

- 1. The Panel recalled that expenditures from the DBCP/SOOP Trust Fund are largely in Euros. Recognizing that the exchange rate between the US dollar and the Euro is affecting more and more the DBCP budget in a negative way, the Panel urges the Members (who have not done so as yet) once more to consider contributing to the DBCP/SOOP Trust Fund in Euros. The Panel notes with appreciation that several Panel Members have already been paying their contribution in Euros in the last four years.
- 2. The Panel urges its members to pay their contributions in a timely fashion.
- 3. In the view of the increasing DBCP activities, especially in Capacity Building, and Pilot Activities, and considering the need to secure the position of the Technical Coordinator, the Panel invites its members not (yet) contributing to the Trust Fund to discuss nationally whether a contribution could be made in the future.
- 4. The Panel also invites members already contributing to the Trust Fund to investigate nationally whether their contribution could be increased.
