Summary and purpose of the document

This document provides for information the financial situation of the DBCP/SOT Trust Fund as of 31 July 2011. It provides the Final Statement for 2010 and the Interim Statement of income and expenses for the employment, travel and logistical support of the Technical Co-ordinator, for travel and support for the DBCP Chairperson and DBCP Representatives, for support to the JTA and for Projects and Activities. The financial information is based on the Statement of Account from IOC and WMO.

ACTION PROPOSED

The Panel will review the status of the DBCP accounts being managed by the joint Secretariat on behalf of the Panel. The Panel, after review, will be invited to approve the financial reports on the DBCP Trust Fund.

-A- DRAFT TEXT FOR INCLUSION IN THE FINAL REPORT

- 11.6.1 The Meeting noted with satisfaction the positive and secure cash balance of funds totaling USD 505,326 as of 31 December 2010, as shown in Appendix E, Table 1.
- 11.6.2 As discussed and decided at the 23rd Session, new budget items such as Capacity Building, Collaborative Arrangement and New Technical Evaluation were introduced. In 2010, USD 47,867 (Appendix F, Table 2) was charged to the Capacity Building line item, in particular for the DBCP CB Workshop (Cape Town, April 2010). Also USD 35,548 was charged to the New Technical Evaluation line item for the DBCP/Iridium Project for upgrade, activation and airtime.
- 11.6.3 The IOC Interim Statement for the period 1 January 31 July 2011 is provided in Appendix B. It shows a positive balance of USD 124,087 as of 31 July 2011. During this period, no contribution was received yet from NOAA on the IOC accounts for DBCP.
- 11.6.4 The WMO Interim Statement for the period 1 January 31 July 2011 is shown in Appendix D. It shows a positive balance of USD 505,366. USD 19,498 corresponding to expenditures for the DBCP Workshop in Mauritius was charged to the Capacity Building line item.
- 11.6.5 The IOC Interim Statement and the WMO Interim Statement are included in the Interim Statement of Accounts for the DBCP/SOOP Trust Fund, as given in Appendix F. It should be noted that, in order to compare the current expenditure level with the budget, this Interim Statement shows the actual expenditure with the budgeted amounts as decided at DBCP-26.
- 11.6.6 The Summary of the Interim Accounts for 2011 of the DBCP/SOT Trust Fund, with no detailed budget lines, is given in Appendix F, Table 1. The Panel noted the JTA budget managed within the DBCP Trust Fund (Appendix H), including the CLS contribution made on behalf of the JTA, and the expenditures for the JTA chairman, the JTA Executive Committee, and the Secretariat, and acknowledged that it did not impact the DBCP budget.
- 11.6.7 The Panel noted with appreciation the provisional table of contributions for 2012 as detailed in Appendix G. The Panel thanked contributing Panel members for their commitments.
- 11.6.8 The Panel recalled that expenditures from the DBCP/SOOP Trust Fund are largely in Euros. Recognizing that the exchange rate between the US dollar and the Euro is affecting more and more the DBCP budget in a negative way, the Panel urged the Members once more to consider contributing to the DBCP/SOOP Trust Fund in Euros (*recommendation*). The Panel noted with appreciation that several Panel Members have already been paying their contribution in Euros in the last two years.
- 11.6.9 The Panel urged its members to pay their contributions in a timely fashion (*recommendation*). In the view of the increasing DBCP activities, especially in Capacity Building, and pilot activities, and considering the need to secure the position of the Technical Coordinator, the Panel invited its members not contributing to the Trust Fund to discuss nationally whether a contribution could be made in the future (*recommendation*). The Panel also invited members already contributing to the Trust Fund to investigate nationally whether their contribution could be increased (*recommendation*).
- 11.6.10 11.6.7 The Panel approved its budget for 2012 (maximal expenditures) as detailed in Appendix F, Table 2. The Executive Board, authorized by the Panel, and taking in account the decisions and recommendations made at the twenty-seventh session of the DBCP, will set a plan for the 2012 actual expenditures. The Executive Board will liaise with Mr Frank Grooters for updating the interim financial report with the most accurate and actual information (*action; DBCP-EB; 31 Jan. 2012*).

- 11.6.11. The Panel requested the joint Secretariats and Mr Grooters to work together to distribute the final statement for the year 2011 to the Panel members as soon as the IOC and WMO Final Statement of Accounts for the year 2011 are finalized (*action; Secretariat & F. Grooters; 1 Mar. 2012*).
- 11.6.12 The Panel nominated again Frank Grooters to act as its financial advisor according to the DBCP operating principles.
- 11.6.13 The Panel thanked Mr Frank Grooters (the Netherlands) for his comprehensive financial report, and the Secretariat for providing timely and valuable financial information to Mr Grooters.

-B- BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 1. The combined DBCP/SOOP Final Account for the year 2010 was produced, as given in Appendix E, together with an estimation of the contributions and expenditures for 2011-2012.
- 2. The combined DBCP/SOOP Final Account for the year 2010 was produced as the combined IOC-WMO Statement of Account, as given in Appendices A and C, respectively.
- 3. The combined detailed accounts for 2011, as given in Appendix F, Table 2, shows the budget as adopted at DBCP-26, for actual expenditures as given by the IOC Interim Statement for the period 1 January 31 July 2011 (Appendix B) and the WMO Interim Statement for the period 1 January 31 July 2011 (Appendix D). It should be understood that several obligations (e.g. Consultancy, DBCP and Representatives Travel and IOC and WMO Support Charges, Technical Co-ordinator Salary) for the remaining part of 2011 are not yet included. It is expected that payments against these line items will occur during the period August-December 2011.
- 4. The Summary of the Interim Accounts for 2011 of the DBCP/SOOP Trust Fund, with no detailed budget lines, is given in Appendix F, Table 1. The balance/carry over is also related to the current situation, where payment for several obligations budgeted for are not yet realized until the end of 2011.
- 5. The actual expenditure reflects a part of the 2011 Direct Cost (e.g. JTA, travel and Capacity Building) and a part of the Indirect Costs (support cost and bank charges).
- 6. As decided at DBCP-24 because of the expected increase of the IOC overhead, the DBCP Chairperson's travel cost is now budgeted under the WMO heading.
- 7. The following points are for clarification of some of the budget items (Appendix F, Table 2):
 - (i) "JTA (chair, EC, Secr.)" corresponds to the contract with the JTA Chairperson, the compensation paid for the Secretariat support to the JTA, and a spending budget related to the work of the JTA Executive Committee. The available total budget is covered by the CLS contribution and does not impact the DBCP budget.
 - (ii) "Travel DBCP Representatives" corresponds to Mr Meldrum's mission to Paris.
 - (iii) "Travel SOT" corresponds to Mr Belbéoch's mission to Hobart for SOT.
 - (iv) "Capacity Building" corresponds to the expenditure for various participants in the Mauritius workshop and a meeting in Tianjin.
 - (v) Because of the vacancy of the TC post, no expenditure for "Tech Coordination" and

- "Travel/Missions Tech Coordinator" was made during the period October 2010 to July 2011.
- (vi) No expenditure for "New Technical Evaluation" (e.g. Iridium Pilot Project) was reported although plans for such expenditures in 2011 as decided by the Panel at DBCP-26 are underway.
- (vii) As decided at DBCP-26 the estimated budget for Capacity Building was increased from USD 25K to USD 45K. (Mauritius workshop USD 25K, India workshop USD 20K). However, the Indian workshop has not been organized in 2011 (see discussion under item 6.4).
- 8. All these expenditures had been either agreed by the Panel as part of its budget for 2011, or approved by the Executive Board during the last inter-sessional period.

Budget for 2012-2013

- 9. Based on the estimates presented at DBCP-26 (Future Commitments), draft tables of income and expenditures have been prepared as in the Appendices to this document. In Appendix F, Table 2, these include, for comparison, the actual expenditures for the year 2010, and the expenditures for the present (incomplete) year 2011 (USD 56,702), including a contingency fund of USD 50,000).
- 10. The total <u>estimated</u> expenditure for the period January to December 2011 is USD 471,000, including a contingency item. With an estimated USD 364,036 to be carried forward from 2011, and the anticipated income of USD 288,710 to be received in 2012, the estimated budget for 2012 is USD 652,746. Hence, with the budgeted level of expenditure, the estimated balance at the end of 2012 is expected to be USD 271,746.
- 11. The following points may be noted;
 - (viii) The costs for travel, new Technical Evaluation, and Capacity Building are variable but are likely to continue to increase due to the expanding requirements of the Panels involvement in the work of the Action Groups, pilot activities, and in organizing workshopsto assist developing countries to take an active role in GOSS and GCOS implementation through JCOMM;
 - (ix) At DBCP-XXIII it was decided to include estimated budget figures for the different activities. Maintaining the level of these figures will result in a decreasing estimated budget (see Appendix F, Table 2). The actual spending however is below the estimations. The Panel is invited to ask the Executive Board to review the level of estimated budget figures for 2012-2013;
 - (x) The additional income from the Ship Observations Team (SOT) participants is reflected in the figures;
 - (xi) As decided at DBCP-XXIV, the DBCP Trust Fund's contribution to the JCOMMOPS Information System operations is budgeted from 2010 onwards at the level of USD 30,000. The support to the JCOMMOPD database license has increased substantially at the level of USD 22,000 in 2011 and at the level of USD 12,000 from 2012 onwards.
- 12. The estimates for the period 2012-2013 include:
 - (i) Cost for the yearly employment of the DBCP Technical Co-ordinator;
 - (ii) The JTA budget, both income (through CLS contribution on behalf of the JTA) and

- expenditures (JTA chair contract and travel, JTA Executive Committee, JTA support to the Secretariat), which is fully supported by the JTA and does not impact the DBCP budget;
- (iii) Costs for the Panel's cross-cutting activities (e.g. capacity-building, collaborative arrangements and new technical evaluation);
- (iv) Outreach and publications (e.g. final report of the session and Annual Report on CD-ROM; and
- (v) Other supplementary cost and contingency.
- 13. At DBCP-26 (Annex VII, DBCP-26 Final Report) a Table of National Contributions was approved (see Appendix G). The Panel is invited to update and approve this table, as appropriate, for the year 2012.
