#### **GENERAL SUMMARY**

The possibility of improving the network of observations from merchant ships between 35°S and 55°S and in relatively sparse oceanic areas during IGY

34. This item is included in view of the obvious necessity of doing everything possible to provide an adequate network. The relevant committee considered this question in detail, and <u>recommendation 14</u> outlines a scheme upon which urgent action is needed. Amplification of this scheme is outlined in <u>annex 3</u> of this report.
