Res. 22 (EC-X) – MODIFICATIONS TO THE INTERNATIONAL METEOROLOGICAL CODES, SPECIFICATIONS AND DESCRIPTIVE TERMS AND INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING METHODS OF CODING

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE,

NOTING Recommendations 1 to 13, 15 to 17, 19 to 29, 31, 33 and 63 (CSM-II);

CONSIDERING the need for bringing the universal meteorological forms of messages and codes up to date as proposed by the Commission for Synoptic Meteorology,

DECIDES:

(1) To adopt Recommendation 1 to 13, 15 to 17, 19 to 29, 31, 33 and 63 (CSM-II);

(2) To issue the necessary amendments to Volume B of WMO publication No. 9 in accordance with the above recommendations;

(3) That these amendments, which will be published in a revised version of Volume B, will come into force on <u>1 January 1960</u>, with the exception of the amendment resulting from Recommendation 3 (CSM-II) – Code for weather bulletins issued for shipping – which will come into force on 1 January 1959;

DIRECTS the Secretary-General :

(1) To make any necessary minor changes in these amendments in consultation with the president of the

Commission for Synoptic Meteorology,

(2) To inform all concerned of this resolution and, in doing so, to send a circular letter with advanced copies of the amendments as approved by the Executive Committee.

(3) To publish and distribute by July 1959 a new edition of Part A, Chapter I of Volume B, WMO publication No. 9, incorporating the changes resulting from this resolution, and also to revise the numbers of the code tables.
