


MET and XBT Observations in the GTS (2002)


Number of MET (■) and XBT (■) Observations in the GTS



VOS and SOOP: No. of Participating Ships




Number of Ships Collecting MET (■) and XBT (■) Observations




Number of Ships Collecting MET and XBT Observations Simultaneously






MET and XBT Observations from Shared Ships (2002–2010)






Number of Ships Collecting MET Observations Only








MET Only Observations (2010)
