E-Logbooks in 2008

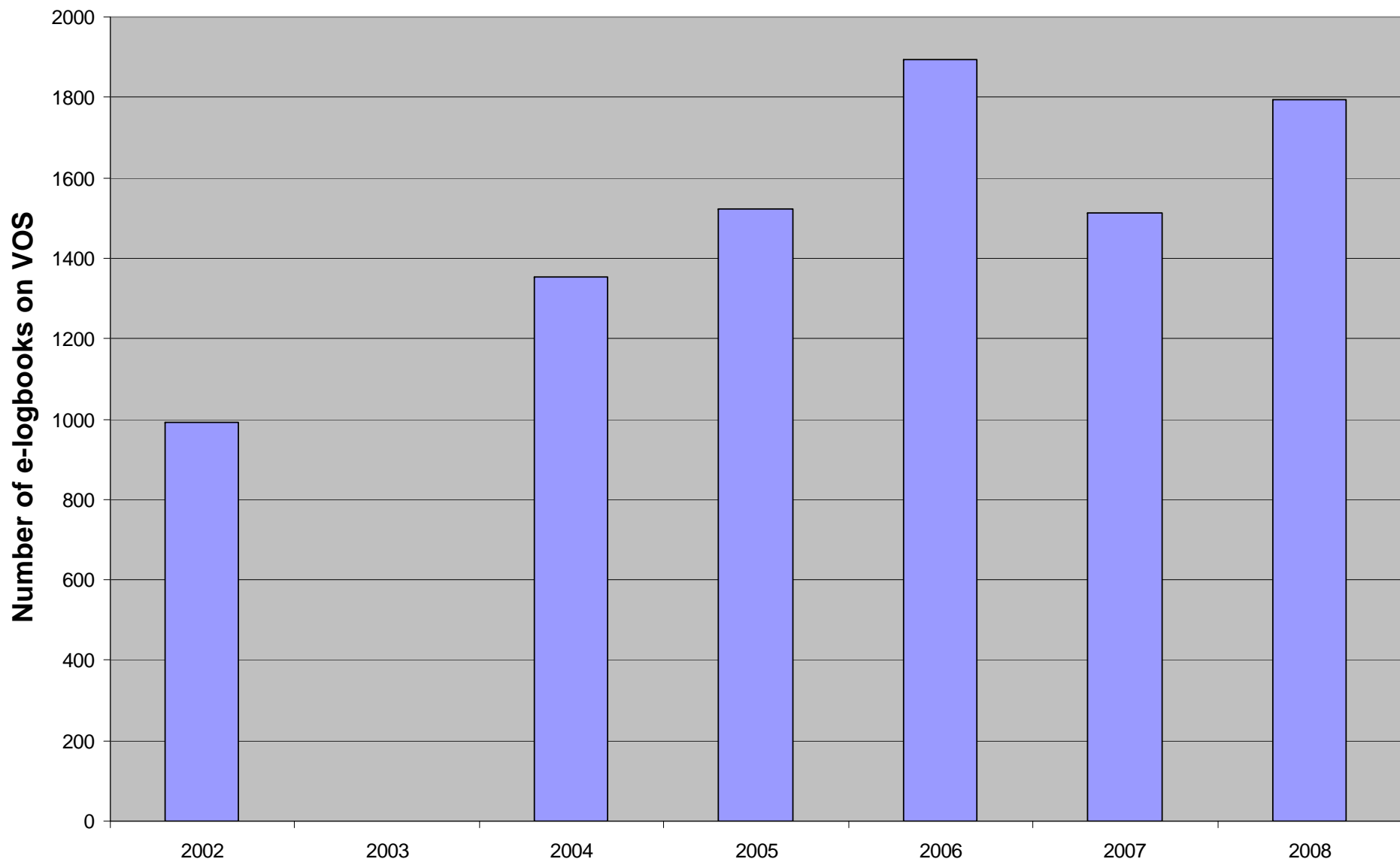
3 Logbook types – 16 countries – 1795 ships

- 5% OBSJMA

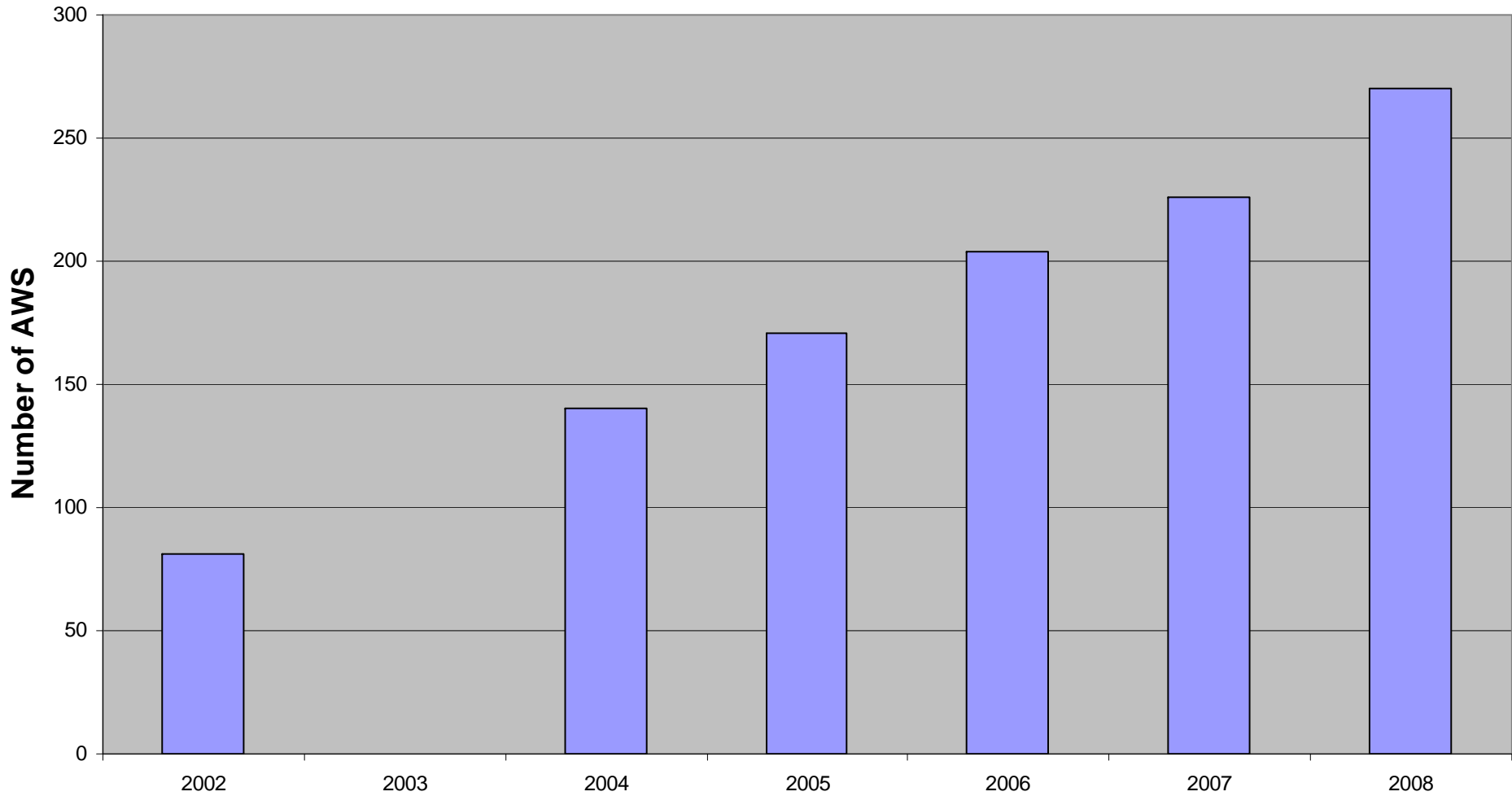
AWS
