Saanich Road Turn left onto McTavish Road At the roundabout, continue straight to stay on McTavish Road Take the British Columbia 17 ramp to Victoria International Airport – YYJ/Vancouver & Gulf Islands Ferry Terminal Merge onto Patricia Bay Hwy/BC-17A Turn right onto Belleville Street/Patricia Bay Hwy/BC-17A continue to follow Belleville Street Turn left onto Oswego Street Take the 1st right onto Quebec Street Destination will be on the left Arrive at 345 Quebec Street.


