

Sri Lanka Disaster Management Act; No.13 of 2005

- ✓ Provides a legal framework for Disaster Risk Management (DRM) in Sri Lanka
- ✓ Addresses Disaster Management (DM) holistically, leading to a policy shift from response based mechanisms to a proactive approach
- ✓ Measures have been taken to amend the act to address the DRM concerns after 05 years of implementation



















Use of Military and Police in Tsunami Warning and Evacuation






All Coastal Police Stations

Use of Police in Tsunami Warning and Evacuation









