Ministerial Declaration

- ✓ African Ministerial Conference on Meteorology (AMCOMET)
- ✓ AMCOMET Bureau composed of Kenya (Chair), Mali (1st VC), Zimbabwe (2nd VC), Congo (3rd VC) & Morocco (Rap)
- ✓ A 10-member Task Force: the 5 Bureau members + Algeria, Cameroon, Ghana, Uganda & Zambia
- ✓ Requested WMO to act as Secretariat

Called for:

- ✓ Development of an African Strategy on Meteorology to effectively meet government and societal needs and requirements for weather and climate information and services
- ✓ Establishment of a Regional Climate Centre in Central Africa
- ✓ Support for NMHSs to meet ICAO requirements
- ✓ Support from technical and financial Partners



Initial GFCS priorities

- Although the GFCS will progressively support all key socioeconomic sectors, for the first 4 years the HLT has proposed to prioritize:
 - > Agriculture
 - Disaster risk reduction
 - > Health
 - > Water
- ✓ These sectors are all interconnected, especially in Africa (33 LDCs)
