- Deadline 2015 MDG Summit Sept 2010
- MDGs at the cornerstone of development policies and activities
- Work of WMO and NMHSs fully supports the MDGs through service delivery

WMO and NMHSs contribution

- Halve the proportion of people without sustainable access to safe drinking water and basic sanitation




FOURTH UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON LDCs
