EXISTING COORDINATION AND COOPERATION MECHANISMS

- > Annual circular letters by PTCs;
- Side meetings to regional events, including Tropical Cyclone/Hurricane Committees meetings;
- ➤ Implementation of pilot and demonstration projects on development of new products: SWFDP/DRR, Heat wave, Flash flood forecasting and cross-cutting projects on drought;



- Regional representatives participation in TCs Management Groups and Implementation Coordination Teams;
- Exchange of lists of WGs and Rapporteurs and harmonization of names of experts in the respective bodies;
- Designation of regional focal points for DRR, PWS, CLIPS and CPA;
- Participation of chairpersons of regional WGs or Rapporteurs in the sessions of relevant TCs.
- Participation of PTCs in sessions of RAs;
- PRAs attending PTC and Joint Meeting PRA-PTC.



WEAKNESSES AND CHALLENGES

> Weaknesses

Differences existing in :

- RAs needs and requirements
- Structures and working mechanisms of RAs
- RAs structure and TCs structure
- Regionalization of TCs planning, operational and research activities
- Programming cycles among RAs and with TCs



> Challenges

- ✓ Mechanism for priority setting?
- ✓ Establishing RAs long term standing structures facilitating proactive interaction between RAs and TCs:

Ex: RAs Task Teams for coordination with CAeM

Resources availability and allotment



> Need for improvement through:

- Complementary roles/actions

RAs (MGs?)
TCs (MGs? Task Teams?)

Sharing best practices among RAs and with TCs



>SOME ACTIONS REQUESTED (Cg, EC, Joint Meeting PRA-PTC)

- GTS modernization and WIS implementation
- Establishment of RCCs (CBS, CCI)
- Maximizing GFCS benefits in Regions, including skills development to apply climate services towards MDGs achievement (CCI, CAgM)
- Disaster Risk Reduction
- Climate change adaptation



WAY FORWARD

- 1. Definition of regional requirements and implementation priorities by RAs
- 2. Organization of activities by TCs to meet the regional requirements
- 3. Identification of joint activity areas by TCs and RAs
- 4. Definition and implementation of the process and corresponding means on a **case by case basis**
