Hazard and Risk analysis – Data Requirements

- Data sharing practices are ill defined.
- Generally there is data hoarding rather than sharing
- Limited or no metadata about the data shared, hence it is difficult to access the data quality
- Insufficient long term data archiving

Hazard and Risk analysis :

Data Requirements _WIGOS

- A database of standards would be developed to:
 - Allow the network managers and operators to easily access the information they need to set-up and run their systems
 - Allow the data users to understand the standards that were used in performing specific observations
- WIGOS will respect the data policies of partner organizations
- WIGOS will strive to ensure that the conditions placed by the originator on the additional data and products are respected
