
1. Conference location

Météo-France - Meteopole - Conference International Centre (hereafter referred to as "CIC") 42 Av G.Coriolis, 31057 Toulouse Cedex, France

2. Shuttle bus and meeting point

→ Airport shuttle to the centre of Toulouse

The airport shuttle is called "Aerocar"

Departure in front of the airport, Arrival Floor – Gate C

Fare (full rate): one way 3,90 €, two ways 5,90 €

Schedule

frequency: 20 minutes Monday to Saturday, from 7.35 a.m.

Sunday and holiday, from 9.15 a.m. last departure from airport: 00.15 a.m.

Stopping places:

1- "Compans"

2- "Place Jeanne d'Arc", for Anatole France, Athénée, Ibis Centre, Mermoz, Raymond IV, St Sernin, Trianon

3- "Allées Jean-Jaurès", for Underground and for hotels Albert 1^{er}, Crown Plaza, Castellane,

Holiday Inn Toulouse Centre Capoul, de France, Citadines Wilson, Grand hotel de l'Opera, Mercure St Georges, Mercure Wilson, Ours Blanc, du Taur, Royal Wilson

4- "Gare Matabiau", for Underground and for hotels Terminus, Phoenicia, Citea hotel, Riquet

→ from the airport to Météo-France

A taxi can drive you to Meteopole in about 15 minutes. It should cost around 20 €.

You can also take the airport shuttle to the stop

"Allées Jean-Jaurès", and then the underground and bus (see below).

→ from the centre of Toulouse to Météo-France

Take the Underground to the last stop "Basso Cambo", then catch a bus on line number 8 , Check that the direction at the front of the bus is "Lycée Polyvalent", then get off at stop "Météo-France". Alternatively, bus 21 heading to "Colomiers Airbus" stops close to Météo-France, at bus stop "Vandel"

An underground + bus ticket costs around 1,50 €.
