INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE TRAINERS

1. Instructions for the Early warning system trainers

- a) Please take note of the time in the agenda for your training session (Doc. 1).
- b) Each trainer is allotted one hour and a half (90 minute) to deliver the training.
- c) We propose the following programme for each 90-minute training session
 - A 50 minute lecture (see section 1.e for guidance)
 - up-to 10-minute movie of your country's early warning system (if available)
 - 30 minute of discussions and Q&A engaging all the participants
- d) The training should be conducted in English. Please speak slowly and clearly to ensure that all participants can follow-up
- e) Content and format of the lecture on your national early warning system:
Please prepare a 50 minute Power Point Presentation per following requirements:
 - This training workshop is focused on institutional coordination and cooperation of the National Meteorological and Hydrological Services and the Disaster Risk Management Agencies in Multi-Hazards Early Warning Systems.
 - The Power Point Presentation should include slides corresponding systematically to the outline provided on page 1 of Doc.3. The content of the slides should address issues raised under the and subtitles in Doc 3.
- f) Following your presentation the moderator of the session will facilitate a 30 minute discussion to ensure a rich discussion engaging the trainees and the trainer.

2. Instructions for the panel discussion on "Capacity Development in Multi-Hazard Early Warning Systems with Focus on Institutional Coordination, Cooperation and NMHSs"

- a) The panel discussion is scheduled on October 2, 2009 from 14:00 to 15:30.
- b) Panelists include trainers from China/Shanghai, Cuba, France, Italy and the USA.
- c) The goals of the panel discussion are to:

- bring out challenges that had to be addressed and opportunities that have been realized in the development of early warning system in the countries of good practices used in the trainings, and
 - compare and contrast approaches of different countries in the implementation of the early warning systems with focus on institutional coordination and cooperation
- d) This panel discussion is organized to allow more time for the trainees to explore and enhance their understanding of early warning systems presented in the training sessions.
- e) The panel will be held in a discussion format with the moderator asking questions to which the trainers will respond.
- f) The trainers are requested to be prepared to provide responses to questions based on issues outlined in Doc 3.
