- Decided to standardize weather, water, climate, space weather and other related environmental hazard and risk information and develop identifiers for cataloguing weather, water and climate extreme events (Resolution 9 (Cg-17) → for CBS to develop a proposal, in collaboration with all TCs and RAs
- Further strengthen WMO (Sec/RAs) partnership with UNISDR and other relevant international and regional partners for the implementation of national / regional projects in line with the Sendai Framework and the UN Plan of Action on DRR for Resilience
- Assist members in the effective implementation of the Sendai Framework through (3.2(1).36, 38):
  - Developing DRR knowledge products
  - Assisting with the coordinated national /regional DRR capacity development activities
  - Promoting, engaging in, and facilitating multi-stakeholder partnerships on different levels



- Leverage existing guidelines, documents (from TCs), gather lessons learned from NMHSs and partners, and identify and fill existing gaps within the DRR Roadmap (3.2(1).33, 34)
- In consultation with Members and collaboration with TCs and RAs:
  Develop a final draft of the WMO DRR Roadmap for consideration and approval by EC-68 in line with international frameworks (3.2(1).39)
- Requests WMO participation in the development and implementation of International Network for MHEWS (IN-MEWS)
- Organize an international MHEWS conference to help facilitate wider implementation and awareness of MHEWS among Members



- Continue with UI-EAGs and develop a set of clear deliverables to allow progress to be tracked. (3.2(1).7) → can contribute to and strengthen the GFCS DRR User Interface Platform (UIP) (3.2(1).18)
- Expand national DRR capacity development projects with regional cooperation frameworks. (3.2(1).8) → Caribbean, SE Europe
- Continue to support the Haiti NMHS (3.2(1).13)
- Programme and their engagement in DRR capacity development projects, submit recommendations to EC on how to promote this approach in other WMO Regions. (3.2(1).14)
- Provide further guidance to Members in the development of knowledge products in the four thematic areas of the DRR Programme. (3.2(1).15)
- Review, regularly update and make accessible DRR training material as a contribution to WMO's Capacity Development Strategy in alignment with the WMO DRR Roadmap. (3.2(1).17)

- For CBS (with CCI & CHy & OCHA): Revise and test Arrangements for the provision of Meteorological Assistance to United Nations Humanitarian Missions described in the manual on the GDPFS (3.2(1).21)
- With the TCs, RAs, RSMCs: Develop draft working arrangement that elaborates roles and responsibilities for the coordination of WMO's response to Members request for assistance. (3.2(1).24)
- Engage in a comprehensive dialogue with GDACS and other thirdparty service providers to facilitate improved cooperation and coordination of activities. (3.2(1).29)
