## 3. Visa Information

# Visa free Entry (Visa waiver)

Foreign nationals entering the Republic of Korea are generally required to have a valid visa. However, a person meeting any one of the following requirements may enter Korea without a visa (Article 7, Section 2 of the Immigration Act).

- Those granted permission or immunity for re-entry that enters before the expiration date.
- Nationals of a country that has signed the visa waiver agreement with the Republic of Korea are subject of exemption.
- Those entering for the interest of international goodwill, travel or purpose beneficial to Korea who
  have been granted permission to enter by presidential decree.
- Those that departed with a refugee travel certification and entering prior to the expiration date.

# **VISA Types**

## Single Entry Visa

Only a single-entry is permitted for the duration of the visa. Valid for 3 months from the date it had been issued.

## Multiple-entry Visa

Multiple entries are permitted for as long as visa remains valid.

#### Valid for:

- Diplomacy (A-1) / Conventions/Agreements (A-3) visa status: 3 years from date of issue.
- Visa provided under multiple-entry visa Agreement: duration specified by an agreement.
- Visa provided for national benefit: duration specified by the Minister of Justice.

#### **Notes**

Should a visa applicant enter Korea prior to the actual issuance of the visa, it will be assumed that the applicant is withdrawing their application, and the issuance will be canceled

Visa applicants must claim their visa within 3 months after:

- the date of application; or
- the notification date of Minister of Justice's approval (applicable only if one is needed).

Otherwise, the applicant must apply for a new visa.



# 6. Transportation: How to get to Korea?

The major arrival points in Korea are the Incheon International Airport (Incheon) and the Gimhae International Airport (Busan). Participants who arrive at the Incheon International Airport can take either the domestic airline to the Gimhae International Airport or KTX (Korea Train Express) to get to Gyeongju. For the WWF7 participants, transport is provided either from the Gimhae International Airport or from the Singyeongju KTX station to the hotel. Travel by train is highly recommended. X Participants who arrive at the airport after 20:30 need to take a KTX(Korea Train Express) train from the Seoul station.

Participants are recommended to take the AREX(Airport Express Train) train from Incheon International Airport to Seoul Station. There are two ways to go to the Seoul station by the AREX train; one is an express train which travels nonstop between the Incheon International Airport and Seoul Station and the other is an all-stop train that stops at several stations including Gimpo International Airport and Digital Media City Station.

To take the AREC train, go to exit B1 at the Incheon Airport. Participants can take the KTX train from Seoul Station to Singyeongju Station.

# 7. General Information

# **Currency and Banks**



The Country's currency is the won (KRW). The exchange rate in recent months is around 1100 KRW for 1 USD. Foreign currencies can be exchanged at airports and government-designated banks. Most of the stores in Korea only accept Korean currency, or KRW, so it is advised that visitors exchange to Korean currency at the airport. Major credit cards are widely accepted, and travelers' checks may be accepted by tourist-oriented shops and at most international tourist hotels and banks. Banks open from 09:00 to 15:30, Mon-Fri, and are closed on weekends and public holidays.

# **Electric Supply**

The voltage used in Korea is 220V/60hz. It requires a "two parallel cylindrical-type" plug.

## **Climate: Temperate with Four Distinct Seasons**

Like the rest of Korea, Gyeongju experiences four distinct seasons. Summers can be hot and humid, while winters are often frigid and accompanied by snow. The autumn is considered particularly beautiful, when the high Korean sky is a crisp blue and Seoul's surrounding hillsides turn a radiant red as the maple leaves turn color. In the downtown area, the yellow leaves of the ginkgo trees bathe the city is a sea of gold.

Located at 37.33 degrees north longitude, Seoul is located in the temperate zone, and at 127 degrees east latitude, it's at the eastern end of the Asian landmass, giving it a coastal climate as well. The yearly average temperature is 11.1 degrees centigrade, with the average August temperate at 25.4 degrees centigrade and the average January temperature at -3.4 degrees centigrade. These are, on the whole, relatively lower temperatures compared to other global cities of its size.
