3. Visa Information

Visa free Entry (Visa waiver)

Visa is a basic requirement for entry and in principle, a foreigner wishing to enter Korea must have a visa. However, a person meeting any one of the following qualification may enter Korean without a visa. (Article 7, Section 2 of the Immigration Act)

- * Those granted permission or immunity for reentry that enters before the expiration date.
- * Nationals of a country that signed visa waiver agreements with Republic of Korea and are thereby subject of exemption.
- * Those entering for the interest of international goodwill, travel, or purpose beneficial to Korea who have been granted permitted to enter by presidential decree.
- * Those that departed with a refugee travel certification and entering prior to the expiration date.

VISA Types

Single Entry Visa

Only a single-entry is permitted for the duration of the visa.

Valid for 3 months from the date it had been issued.

Multiple-entry Visa

Multiple entries are permitted for as long as visa remains valid.

Valid for:

- Diplomacy (A-1) / Conventions/Agreements (A-3) visa status: 3 years from date of issue.
- Visa provided under multiple-entry visa Agreement: duration specified by an agreement.
- Visa provided for national benefit: duration specified by the Minister of Justice

Notes

Should a visa applicant enter Korea prior to the actual issuance of the visa, it will be assumed that the applicant is withdrawing their application, and the issuance will be canceled Visa applicant must claim their visa within 3 months after:

- -the date of application or
- -the notification date of Minister of Justice's approval (applicable only if one is needed) Otherwise, the applicant must apply for a new visa.


6. Transportation: Incheon International Airport to the Hotel

Limousine Bus: No. 6001 (about 90 minutes/ 13,000 KRW)

First bus 05:40 / Last bus 22:25

Interval Time: 30 Min


You can get this bus in <u>6A or 12B bus station</u> at the 1st floor of the airport. It takes about one and half hours or two hours. We strongly recommend you use this bus as there is the bus stop in the right front of the hotel.

Taxi

In 4D (international taxi) or 6c (taxi for Seoul city), you can use a taxi from the airport to the hotel. Generally, it takes 70 minutes with about 80,000 KRW (it is flexible to traffic condition).





1st Floor in the Airport

Airport Railroad & Line 5 Subway


You can use the airport railroad (AREX) to get the hotel. To reach the Gimpo Int'l Airport station, you take this Airport Railroad, and then you transfer to Line 5 Subway. In Line 5, you arrive in Dongdaemun History & Culture Park station after twenty four stops. EULJIRP CO-OP RESIDENCE hotel is located from just 5 minute walk from Exit No.14 of Dongdaemun History & Culture Park station. If you choose this way, it takes about one and half hours to the hotel. Total fare is 4,600 KRW.

7. General Information

Currency and Banks



The Country's currency is the won (KRW). The exchange rate in recent months is around 1000 KRW for 1 USD. Foreign currencies can be exchanged at airports and government-designated banks. Most of the stores in Korea only accept Korean currency, or KRW, so it is advised that visitors exchange to Korean currency at the airport. Major credit cards are widely accepted, and traveler's checks may be accepted by tourist-oriented shops and at most international tourist hotels and banks. Banks open from 09:00 to 15:30, Mon-Fri and are closed on weekends and public holidays.

Electric Supply

The voltage used in Korea is 220V/60hz. It requires a "two parallel cylindrical-type" plug.

Climate: Temperate with Four Distinct Seasons

Like the rest of Korea, experiences four distinct seasons. Summers can be hot and humid, while winters are often frigid and accompanied by snow. The autumn is considered particularly beautiful, when the high Korean sky is a crisp blue and Seoul's surrounding hillsides turn a radiant red as the maple leaves turn color. In the downtown area, the yellow leaves of the ginkgo trees bathe the city is a sea of gold.

Located at 37.33 degrees north longitude, Seoul is located in the temperate zone, and at 127 degrees east latitude, its at the eastern end of the Asian landmass, giving it a coastal climate as well. Its yearly average temperature is 11.1 degrees centigrade, with the average August temperate at 25.4 degrees centigrade and the average January temperature at -3.4 degrees centigrade. These are, on the whole, relatively lower temperatures compared to other global cities of its size.
