Deficiency

The SAP coverage is very broad and covers all possible water-related activities. There are too many SAP Action Domains and these contain too many actions, resulting in a SAP that is hardly achievable if trying to implement them in the same time.

Proposed action

Prioritize the SAP actions so that the highest priority actions reflect flood forecasting system development (and not data rescue issues, flood design calculations etc.).

Take into account of these actions in further FFI documentation (e.g. generic list of requirements/best practices of flood forecasting).

Deficiency

The SAP approach and its documentation are too lengthy and complex, resulting in its not being transparent nor it's being broadly adopted.

- 2. Use high priority actions and recommendations in further FFI documentation (generic list of requirements, guidance material etc.).

- make sure FFI components include requirements;
- Develop guidance material for different audiences;
- Develop and promote training material;
