#### Introduction to the MRCS

- MRCS recognizes its role as auxiliary to the Government in humanitarian services.
- The legal base for the National Society is the 1959 "Burma Red Cross Act" which has been amended in 1971, 1988 and in 1998.
- In 1988 the National Society was renamed "Myanmar Red Cross Society".



#### Introduction to the MRCS

- Myanmar Red Cross Society (MRCS) Law Revised in August 2015
- Purpose to serve independently, voluntary and as an auxiliary of the State in the humanitarian field
- Carry out humanitarian services in line with its fundamental principles such as Humanity, Independence, Impartiality, among others



- MRCS is member of two national level committees in Disaster Management, and contributes to the Contingency Plan of the Humanitarian Country team and the MAPDRR.
- MRCS is working closely with the Ministry of Social Welfare, Relief and resettlement, and the Department of Meteorology and Hydrology in areas of DM/DRR.
- MRCS is also a member of the Health
  Subcommittee, and is widely recognized as
  working close with the Ministry of Health in the
  area of primary health and health education.



#### Selected objectives of the MRCS:

- To assist and protect any person without discriminating the race, religion, color, status, poverty, wealth, sex, language, political belief;
- To participate the society in the national level preparedness and response programs in natural disasters, man-made disasters and other emergency matters;
- To establish the effective national level network for reunion of family relationships between the separated people in the necessary situations of humanitarian due to armed conflicts, terrorisms, natural or man-made disasters



# MRCS Emergency Operations Center-EOC Introduction

- Set up EOC at Napyitaw first, equipment supported by IFRC
- Set up EOC at Yangon supported by AmRC (1-9-14)
- EOC run normal activities & EW coordinate with DMH, RRD and respecting RC branches
- Start activate at the same time with National EOC in previous 2015-Flood (Komen Cyclone)



#### **MRCS Emergency Operations Center-EOC**

#### Role of the MRCS EOC

- Information management
  - Collect, manage and analyze the information available from various sources including DMH, RRD, GAD, National EOC, township branches
- Communication
  - Provide tools and common platform for communicating with branches, volunteers, government and other humanitarian organizations



#### **MRCS Emergency Operations Center-EOC**

#### **Role of the MRCS EOC**

- Coordination
  - Ensure physical space and staff are available for coordination with internal and external stake holders (including DMH, RRD, GAD, national EOC)
- Business continuity
  - Support continuation of MRCS business operations in the times of disasters with living space and supplies for key staff

MRCS EOC activated for the first time during July-August 2015 floods response

#### MRCS EOC Linkage with the DMH

- Regularly monitors the DMH Facebook page for daily weather bulletins
- Receive alerts by Fax from the DMH for any abnormal weather conditions
- Communicates the early warning information to the State/Region and township branches
- Provides recommendations for early action by branches and communities
- Facilitates the early action by branches and communities and provides relevant support as feasible



#### Activities (Normal Time)

- Monitor and Analysis of disaster information and weather forecast from DMH, DMIS-AHA center, international weather websites, TV and online media
- Submit weather situation report to ECs and Director
- Disseminate weather situation issued by DMH to the respective States / Regions in time by sms, phone, fax, messenger and viber
- Support to the response activities within DM and logistic, branch in small scale disaster




# Emergency Management Experience in Flood

- Opened EOC when start Flood and watch the disaster situation
- Received information from RCVs in terms of Flood response operation in effected areas
- MRCS SG lead coordination meeting for flood response with DM team, Health, logistics, HV&C, ICRC, IFRC, AmRC
- Movement Partners (MRCS, IFRC, ICRC and PNS) started working for DREF proposal.
- Then, MRCS, ICRC, IFRC tripartite meeting for Flood Response Operation
- MRCS deployed EOC officer to National EOC as requested
- Conduct Flood operation meeting with all Departments & PNS
- EOC officer supported Travel Authorizations and custom clearance process for emergency operation.




# Early Warning Alert System

- EWEA system (HF SSB radio network, Satellite ph,...)








