

Encountered Weather Condition From April, 2017 to January 2018


- On 16th 2017, the Department of Meteorology and Hydrology announced Red Alert for Maarutha Cyclone which caused flash flood in Mann Stream.
- Continuous heavy rain from 1st to 5th January, 2018 made flash flood and higher the water level in Mann Stream.

Flash Flood Experience Within Maarutha Cyclone

- Because of Maarutha Cyclone Alert from the Department of Meteorology and Hydrology, early warning for the civilians residing near plateaus, rivers and streams to be careful and stay alert was effectively notified.
- The provisional resorts that built in the Mann Stream were evacuated in time.
- Precautions were effective and successful because of early cyclone alert.
- Updated Weather forecast announcements by the department of Meteorology and Hydrology were informed just in time to the Wards and Villages by telephones and faxes.

Preparation for the Flash Flood

- ✤ Listen weather forecast regularly.
- Collect foods, medicines, drinking water, candles, matches, torches, etc..
- ✤ Find the ways ahead to escape from flash flood.
- ✤ Make a plan ahead for the security of the family.
- ✤ Cooperate the precautions for the flash flood.
- ✤ Find the ways not to be out of informations and communication.
- ✤ Inform and communicate each other.

Preparation before Flash Flood

- Preparing before flash flood.
- Evacuate the cattles ahead before flash flood.
- ✤ Transfer to higher ground where the water can't reach.
- ✤ Collect the life saving materials.
- ✤ Make plan within family.
- ✤ Participate in precaution plans.
- ✤ Observe the escape ways.
- ✤ Rehearse the drills.

Things to do during Flash Flood

- ✤ Avoid walking along the bank in the flood area.
- ✤ Cooperate with the disaster management teams.
- ✤ Beware of poisonous animals.
- Listen carefully the announcement of the weather forecast.
- Prioritize safty of the family.
- ✤ Beware of climate change.
- ✤ Be purified the drinking water.

Things to do after Flash Flood

- ✤ Care for the health and safety of family members.
- Drink boiled water to protect diarrhea.
- ✤ Keep environment clean.
- ✤ Drinking water distribution system must be recovered.
- Participate in disaster manugement movements.
- ✤ Be alert for the news of river water-level.
- ✤ Keep on doing rehabilitations.
- ✤ Make the list of damages.
- Cooperate with the rescue teams.

Suggestions for the better forecast announcements

For the better announcements of weather forecast, Myanmar's communication networks such as SMS and social medias are effective and rapid ways to connect with the public all the time.

Experiences of flash flood in Minbu District

- When the water level of the Ayeyawady river gets higher because of flash flood, dwellers besides the river might be face with flood and river bankslide.
- Storms and flsh flood can be occured by Cyclones.

Preparations for the flash flood

- Forming District level and Township level Disaster Mananement Committee.
- Building a communication system for the better information.
- Building temporary shelter.
- Forming rescue teams ahead.

Emergency responses during flash flood

- Emergency search and rescue of missing persons due to disaster.
- Evacuation of the victims to the safety area and providing accommodation in temporary shelters.
- Emergency supporting of food and relief items.
- Clearance of damage and collecting preliminary data on losses and making examinations for necessaries to provide.
- Opening an emergency management centre and closely supervised the disaster.
- Providing emergency health care to the local people and prevention of the outbreak of contagious diseases by forming mobile healthcare teams.
- Providing medical treatment to the injured and the sick by opening temporary clinics and hospitals. 24

- Conducting emergency responses including search and rescue accorind to the type of disaster.
- Performing other duties assigned by this law in respect of emergency responses including search and rescue.
- Data collection and confirmation of damage and losses due to disaster.
- Providing the continuation of sufficient food, relief and rehabilitation items, appropriate and financial assistance from the alloted funds to the victims.
- Laying down the plan for rehabilitation and reconstruction on the situation of damage and losses.
- Reconstruction of buildings and houses damaged by the disaster in an appropriate area as disaster-resilient buildings.

- Rehabilitation in order to restore agriculture, livestock breedings and other vocations required for victims.
- Establishment of reintegration into society by uplifting to the mental affected person due to disaster.\
- Providing medical treatment to the victims and taking preventive measures against the contagious disease that is likely to cause as supplementary.
- Taking measures for the safety of the victims and rule of law in the disaster affected area.
- Coordination with the relevant body of the prevention against human trafficking for the prevention against human trafficking to the victims.
- Performing other duties assigned by this law in respect of rehabilitation and reconstruction ativities.
