# Objectives of the 1st Meeting of the Southeast Asia Project Steering Committee (SEA-PSC-1)

*23 November, 14:00 – 17:00*

- Provide an overview of the **expected outcomes** and components of the project & **progress to date**
- Set up a steering mechanism & agree on its **Terms of Reference (ToR)**
- Discuss and approve the proposed activities included in the draft **Implementation Plan (IP)** in light of **previously identified needs & existing national and regional strategies and plans**
- Synergize with relevant **on-going projects in SEA**
- Agree on **next steps until Mar 2018 & a work plan until Mar 2019**



# Review of decisions/actions

- Update the information on third-party activities/projects in SeA with information from the NMHs
- Formulate needs that could be addressed by future projects
- Change “SEA” to “SeA”, add “SeA-” to PSC
- Update the ToR with the proposed changes, also trying to shorten them

# Next steps

- **Prepare the minutes/report of the SEA-PSC-1 and share for review (Project Manager – PM)**
- **Share the Project Overview, updated narrative Activity Plan, higher level Implementation Plan, and Work Plan (until March 2019) for review (PM)**
- **Set-up of a project website on the WMO public website (& protected workspace if required) (PM)**

**→ By 7 December 2017**

- **Letters of commitment and nomination of members and alternate members/focal point from the beneficiary countries/NMHSs to the WMO Secretary-General (NMHSs) → as soon as possible**
- **Work on a data exchange policy with the SWFDP-SeA and SEAFFGS in order to improve the forecasting and guidance products (NMHSs, WMO Mgmt.) → as soon as possible**
- **Call for hosting the next meeting (SEA-PSC-2) in Q4 2018, possibly in conjunction with another project activity or WMO-related meeting (NMHS)**
