DISCLAIMER

Regulation 43

Recommendations of working groups shall have no status within the Organization until they have been approved by the responsible constituent body. In the case of joint working groups the recommendations must be concurred with by the presidents of the constituent bodies concerned before being submitted to the designated constituent body.

Regulation 44

In the case of a recommendation made by a working group between sessions of the responsible constituent body, either in a session of a working group or by correspondence, the president of the body may, as an exceptional measure, approve the recommendation on behalf of the constituent body when the matter is, in his opinion, urgent, and does not appear to imply new obligations for Members. He may then submit this recommendation for adoption by the Executive Council or to the President of the Organization for action in accordance with Regulation 9(5).

DECLARATION OF INTENT TO CONTRIBUTE TO REFERENCE CDMS TOOL SET

Recognizing that:

- (1) Successful delivery of climate services is dependent upon reliable climate information,
- (2) Implementation of good practice for management of climate-relevant information requires software tools,
- (3) The large variety of software climate data management systems in use by members of WMO represents significant duplication of effort and that few, if any, of these tools fully implement the best practice described in the Climate Data Management System Specification (WMO-No. 1131),
- (4) An reference Climate Data Management System (CDMS) developed using open source practices would reduce the level of duplication, allow many organizations to raise the standard of CDMS they used, allow standard statistics on the effectiveness of climate data management to be gathered, and allow public scrutiny of the procedures used in the management of climate-relevant information,
