- Global EPS products are routinely used in the forecasting process in each country for time scales from hours to weeks
  - Probabilistic products or services are issued to at least some of the sectors in each country
  - EPS products available to Members in digital format for ingest to digital forecasting systems
  - Observation and verification systems existing to support the forecasting and verification

# What training tasks are required for the transition to operations and ongoing support?

---

- 'Clarification of competencies for forecasting and service delivery tasks.
  - Carry out learning needs analysis against the country requirements and capabilities for now and 5 years time in line with the agreed competencies
  - Capability analysis of the NMHS infrastructure to access, use and deliver products and services

# What activities could support training for the transition to operations and ongoing support?

---

- Establishment and implementation of SWFDP Training Desks at regional centres.
  - Attachments to training desks at regional centres
  - Utilization and creation of regular weather briefings from the regional centres along the lines of the VL weather briefings
  - Involvement of regional training centres for ongoing regional and national training and support.
  - Ongoing training events aimed at ??? using a mix of face-to-face and distance learning techniques
