Background

Expert Team on Operational Metrology (ET-OM) meeting will be held in Ljubljana, Slovenia, from 1st - 4th December 2015. It is hosted by Regional Instrument Center of the Slovenian Environment Agency.

The meeting will start on Tuesday, 1st December 2015, at 9:00 at Slovenian Environment Agency (4th floor).

The workshop will be conducted in English and training material will be available in English only. No interpretation will be provided to other WMO languages.

Entry formalities

Some participants from foreign countries may require a visa to enter Slovenia. You are encouraged to apply for a visa as soon as possible. The timeframes for visa processing are difficult to predict with accuracy for any individual applicant and could vary significantly by country. You need to contact the Slovenian consulate in your country (or the consulate of another EU country that may handle visa applications for Slovenia) and enquire about the necessary documentation to be provided. Information on entry formailites can be found at Slovenian Ministry of Foreign Affairs: http://www.mzz.gov.si/en/. If needed, organiser will provide a *Letter of Guarantee* for the visa application. This letter cannot assure the issuance of a visa. **Visas are not issued at the airport on arrival in Slovenia.**

Currency, exchange, use of credit cards

Local currency is Euro. All major credit cards are accepted virtually everywhere. On the 12. October 2015 the exchange rate is: 1 € EURO = 1.12 \$ USD

Transportation from Ljubljana Airport to the Ljubljana

The cheapest option is by bus. The journey costs €4.10 and takes around an hour. The AlpeTour service (http://www.lju-airport.si/pripone/1932/Vozni_red_letalisce_2014_verzija_10_3_2014.pdf) seems to be most frequently used. 
Those wishing a little more comfort in their bus ride have a plethora of *Shuttle* options to choose from. There are many from which to choose, with our favourites being *GoOpti* (rates starting at €9) and *Na Letališče* (starting from €8). The journey takes around 30 minutes. Ring ahead to your company of choice to confirm a seat.

A taxi from the airport to Ljubljana will cost from €40 to €45.

Electricity

Standard voltage in Slovenia is 230 V 50Hz. The standard frequency is 50 Hz. The power sockets that are used are of type F.

TimeLocal time in Slovenia is Central European Time (UTC+1:00).

Meeting venue

Ljubljana climate in December

There are three climatic influences that meet in Slovenia. A harsh Alpine climate prevails in the mountains, the coast has a sub-Mediterranean climate, and the north-east lowlands have a continental climate. The average temperature in Ljubljana is slightly above 1 °C in December. Due to the fact that Ljubljana is citied in Alpine region some snow in December is typical for this period of year. Particularly due to winter months, Ljubljana experiences the so called temperature inversion, a meteorological phenomena when cool and moist air is trapped close to the ground.

Please, check the current weather at www.meteo.si. Some basic climatic facts on meteorological situation in December:
