Report of the Chairperson

- 1. Following the 10th Session of the CIMO Management Group, October 2012, the Task Team on Aircraft-Based Observations (TT-AO) was formed to manage the scientific, metrology and standards related aspects of aircraft-based observations.
- 2. The TT-AO has a small Membership consisting of Members with diverse experience in meteorology. The Members were selected to provide several fields of expertise that could be assigned to Tasks within the TT-AO Work Plan.
- 3. The TT-AO will be in place until CIMO XVI in 2014.
- 4. The TT-AO also benefits from Secretariat participation and support.
- 5. The following activities of the TT-AO are to be noted:
 - a. During January/February 2013, the Membership and draft Terms of reference of the TT-AO were proposed.
 - b. By the beginning of May 2013, the TT-AO Membership was confirmed and approved by their respective PRs. A Draft Work Plan and Budget had also been circulated for comment, review and finalisation.
 - c. By the end of May 2013, the TT-AO Work Plan and Budget was finalised and agreed. The Tasks contained within the Work Plan were assigned Task Leaders, Deliverables and Timescaleas as well as Budget Funding where required.
 - d. A series of Webex Sessions were held prior to and following the CBS Expert Team on Aircraft-Based Observations (ET-ABO) Meeting in September 2013.
 - 1st July: Two sessions to allow discussion with all Members due to time zone differences.
 - 20th Aug: Withdrawal of one of TT-AO Members. Chair and SO/ARO looking for replacement.
 - iii. 26th Sep: Update to Work Plan and review of Tasks.
 - iv. 10th Oct: Review Work Plan and discussion on plans for Task 10.
 - v. 1st Nov: Change in TT-AO Membership and addition of new Task. TT-AO-1 meeting planned for 18-20th February 2014.
 - vi. 8th Nov: Review of Work Plan and Tasks. TT was advised of status of proposed update to ARINC620 to harmonise with AOSFRS.
 - vii. 21st Nov: Review of Work Plan and Tasks. Further discussions regarding ARINC620 and AOSFRS harmonisation.
 - viii. 17-18th Dec: Following 21st Nov Webex, a meeting of S Taylor (Chair), D Lockett and A Hoff was arranged to review ARINC620/AOSFRS specification documents.
 - ix. 5th Feb: Final preparation discussions (Chair and SO/ARO) for TT-AO-1.
 - e. The above Webex Sessions, email exchanges and TT-AO participation at ET-ABO-1 has enabled the Work Plan and associated Tasks to progress well.
