INFORMATION ON LOCAL ARRANGEMENTS

Here is some information to assist you with planning of travel and accommodation for ODRRGOS-5.

The meeting will be held at Wadham College, Oxford, which is at the southern end of Parks Road. A good map of central Oxford can be found at

The meeting will start at 10.00 hours on 1 July, and you are welcome to arrive at Wadham College from 09.00 hours.

Accommodation

A list of hotels is included hereafter. This is only a selection of hotels in Oxford, including some of the more conveniently located ones. Let us know if you have a problem contacting any of these, or if you would like a more complete list, which we could fax to you. I advise to **book early**, as July is a busy time for visitors in Oxford.

As an alternative, it would be possible for you to be accommodated at Wadham College at a rate of 41 UK pounds per night (including breakfast). These are student rooms and they do not have ensuite facilities, but they are of good size and quality (I have checked them out). If you are interested in this option, please contact us.

TravelFrom Heathrow or Gatwick airports, the easiest method of travel to Oxford is by bus:

Airport	cost	frequency	travel time
Heathrow	15 UKpounds (return)	every 30 minutes	~ 1 hour
Gatwick	22 UKpounds (return)	every hour	~ 2 hours

Pay the driver in cash (credit cards not accepted). For more details, see http://www.theairline.info. Either take the bus to the terminus in central Oxford (Gloucester Green bus station) and then short taxi ride, or ask the driver if he passes close to your hotel.

I do not advise to use a car, unless you need it for other travel in the UK. Parking is very limited in central Oxford. Several hotels are within walking distance of Wadham College, otherwise the local bus service is good.

Other matters

We are arranging for a buffet lunch to be provided at Wadham College for each day of the meeting. Please let us know if you have any special dietary requirements.

Wadham College is only 5 minutes walk from the main shopping centre of Oxford, where there are several banks with cash machines and bureaux de change.
