## 5. Argos monthly status report

5.1 As at 1 March 1988, the Argos service was handling reports from 501 drifting buoys, 78 moored buoys, 1 balloon, 16 ships, 78 animal trackings, 411 fixed stations and 171 miscellaneous platforms. A daily mean of 1092 DRIBU reports from 156 drifting buoys and 2 BATHY reports from 1 selected ship were transmitted to the RTH Paris for insertion into the GTS. The list of platforms reporting through Argos and distributed over the GTS is given below.
